This privacy policy sets out how the South Coast Scramble Club uses and protects any information that you give us when you use our website, Facebook or to enter our events.

The South Coast Scramble Club is committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected. Should we ask you to provide certain information by which you can be identified when becoming a member, entering an event, using our website or Facebook, then you can be assured that it will only be used in accordance with this privacy statement.

The South Coast Scramble Club may change this policy from time to time by updating this page. You should check this page from time to time to ensure that you are happy with any changes. This policy is effective from the 17th of May 2018.

WHAT WE COLLECT

We may collect the following information:

- name and date of birth/age;
- contact information including email address;
- demographic information such as postcode, preferences and interests;
- other information relevant to customer surveys, offers and events.

WHAT WE DO WITH THE INFORMATION WE GATHER

We require this information to understand your needs and provide you with a better service, and in particular for the following reasons:

- Internal record keeping;
- We may use the information to improve our services and events;
- We may periodically send promotional emails about new events, announcements or other information which we think you may find interesting using the email address which you have provided;

 From time to time, we may also use your information to contact you for market research purposes. We may contact you by email, phone, or mail. We may use the information to customise the website according to your interests.

SECURITY

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure, we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.

HOW WE USE COOKIES

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive. Once you agree, the file is added, and the cookie helps analyse web traffic or lets you know when you visit a particular site. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual. The web application can tailor its operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences.

We use traffic log cookies to identify which pages are being used. This helps us analyse data about web page traffic and improve our website in order to tailor it to customer needs. We only use this information for statistical analysis purposes and then the data is removed from the system.

Overall, cookies help us provide you with a better website, by enabling us to monitor which pages you find useful and which you do not. A cookie in no way gives us access to your computer or any information about you, other than the data you choose to share with us.

You can choose to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. This may prevent you from taking full advantage of the website.

VISITORS TO OUR WEBSITES

When someone visits <u>www.southcoastscrambleclub.com</u> we use a third party service, Google Analytics, to collect standard internet log information and details of visitor behaviour patterns. We do this to find out things such as the number of visitors to the various parts of the site. This information is only processed in a way which does not identify anyone. We do not make, or allow Google to make, any attempt to find out the identities of those visiting our website.

LINKS TO OTHER WEBSITES

Our website may contain links to other websites of interest. However, once you have used these links to leave our site, you should note that we do not have any control over that other website. Therefore, we cannot be responsible for the protection and privacy of any information which you provide whilst

visiting such sites and such sites are not governed by this privacy statement. You should exercise caution and look at the privacy statement applicable to the website in question.

CONTROLLING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

The collection or use of your personal information can be restricted in the following ways:

- whenever you are asked to fill in a form, look for the box that indicates you do not want the
 information to be used by anybody for direct marketing purposes and make sure it is
 unchecked;
- if you have previously agreed to us using your personal information for direct marketing purposes, you may change your mind at any time by emailing us at southcoastscrambleclub@gmail.com

We will not sell, distribute or lease your personal information to third parties unless we have your permission or are required by law to do so. We may use your personal information to send you promotional information about third parties which we think you may find interesting if you tell us that you wish this to happen.

GOOGLE ANALYTICS

Google Analytics uses cookies to collect information about how visitors use our site. The cookies collect information in an anonymous form, including the number of visitors to the site, where visitors have come to the site from and the pages they visited. We use Google Analytics information to understand how our web site is performing and to help us improve the site. These are Category 2 cookies.
